Please keep the school office updated with your current phone numbers and physical address.

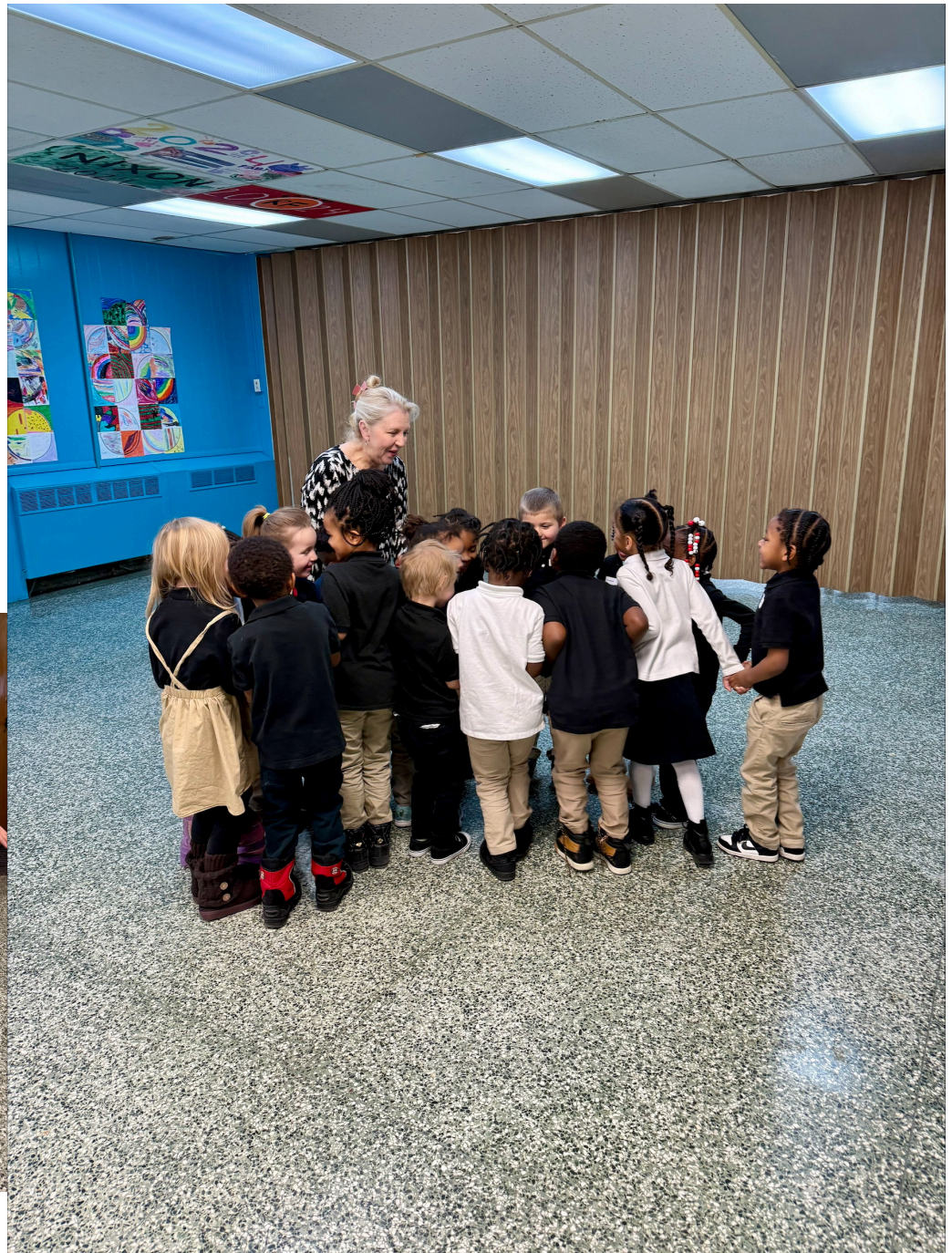


# Canton Ballet
